

AN EXHIBITION OF PHOTOGRAPHS by
DAISAKU IKEDA

Daisaku Ikeda, President of the Soka Gakkai International, in his ardent desire to promote lasting peace, has engaged in dialogue with world leaders, scholars and cultural figures to deepen mutual understanding. He has also encouraged a wide variety of grass-roots cultural exchanges on the part of ordinary citizens.

Whenever an opportunity has presented itself, in whatever locale, whether abroad or at home in Japan, Mr. Ikeda has photographed scenes of nature that have touched his heart. This exhibition features a selection of photos taken during Mr. Ikeda's travels for peace to more than 50 countries over the past 40 years, and is accompanied by poems inspired by his interactions with nature and the cosmos.
